

Halloween Black Hats

Prep Time: 15 minutes

Makes: 30 hats

CChints: This is a fun and easy treat that the children can help with. You need a cookie with chocolate icing on the bottom or top or both to use as the hat brim. Or you can use a chocolate, chocolate chip cookie or a chocolate sandwich cookie. We like Keebler® Fudge Stripes™ cookies. You can use your favorite chocolate candy, either plain chocolate or one with a nut or caramel filling. These can be made a day or two ahead as long as you cover them with plastic wrap.



11.5 ounce or so bag of chocolate cookies

12 ounce bag chocolate kisses

1 small tube of yellow or red writing gel or icing

Locate your serving tray. Lay the cookies on the tray chocolate icing side up.

Unwrap enough chocolate candies for each cookie. Do this away from the serving tray so pieces of foil or paper don't get on the cookies.

Open the writing gel and run a stream around the bottom edge of the chocolate candy so it looks like a hat ribbon. Gently press and place it on center of the cookie.

Cover the tray with plastic wrap or foil so they stay fresh until you are ready to serve them.
